FOR FULL FUNDING OF THE DDDS DSP RATE

I am signing this petition to ask the Delaware General Assembly to pass **House Bill 433** introduced by Representative Melanie George Smith in June 2016.

House Bill 433 takes an important step forward by adding funds to the Division of Developmental Disabilities Services (DDDS) budget* so that payment rates for providers can be set according to the 2014 market study, which would allow providers to increase the average pay for Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) to \$12.75 an hour <u>and</u> to cover their other costs of doing business.

People with intellectual and developmental disabilities rely on DSPs to live safe and fully integrated lives, as required by the Statewide Transition Plan. Family members want to have a more stable workforce serving their loved ones, instead of the high staff turnover levels that currently exist. DSPs need better pay, so they don't have to work two jobs just to support themselves and their families.

*Note: HB 433 would increase DDDS funding over a three year period (2017 – 2020). It will take \$17.86 million in state funds to reach the market rate, combined with \$21.14 million in federal matching funds (FY 2017 FMAP), for a total of \$39 million.
